The regular meeting of the Narragansett School Committee was held on March 16, 2016, at the Narragansett Town Hall, Assembly Area, 25 Fifth Avenue, Narragansett, Rhode Island.

School Committee Reports:

Mr. White reported that the recent Narragansett Recreation Advisory Board meeting was held on Monday evening. At the meeting, the Board discussed beach sustainability and had expert Dennis Lynch speak about the different aspects of beach erosion, the sea wall, and the road heights/ levels.

Mr. deWardener informed the Committee about the recent Technology Committee meeting at which they previewed the new District webpage that is currently being worked on.

Mr. Ranaldi spoke about the Narragansett Education Foundation and invited resident and Board President Phil Capaldi to speak about the NEF (Narragansett Education Foundation) and funding efforts to support the Narragansett School System.

Superintendent's Report:

Ms. Sipala informed the Committee that she is working together with the Town on a Trolley proposal which will allow a private company to offer trolley service using the school parking lots for parking.

Ms. Sipala explained to the Committee that letters went out to parents regarding the 2016 PARCC state assessments indicating that this is the way we will determine whether students are making progress on our statewide, grade-level learning expectations. Federal law requires annual statewide assessments, and holds schools and districts accountable for attaining at least 95 percent student participation. The results provide schools with important data about student achievement and assist us in providing targeted, personalized instruction for our students. Testing begins on March 28th in our schools.
